Friends of Oak Ridge Cemetery Buchanan, Michigan

Friends of Oak Ridge Cemetery was started in April 2003 as a Buchanan, Michigan area volunteer organization dedicated to "Preserving Our Heritage." Much of the organization's efforts have centered on the cleaning and repair of 19th century grave stones and markers in Buchanan's Oak Ridge Cemetery. The Oak Ridge friends also conduct walking tours and educational history lectures for the Buchanan community. Finally, they are a repository of family history information used by genealogical researchers. In 2005 members of Friends helped finalize and distribute Russ and Mary Chadderdon's index of 8,000 Oak Ridge related names. Since 2006, Friends of Oak Ridge Cemetery has published a quarterly newsletter. An archive and index follows. Current organization contact information can be found in the most recent newsletter.
