### Roles & Responsibilities

- Roles of OpenJS & LF
  - The Foundation has a menu of services - it will be providing a set of vendors/plans and assisting projects with the management of those services via OpenJS & LF Staff
  - Foundation will manage access control (who has access)

- Role of the Project & Maintainers
  - Project maintainers should be able to self-manage their servers, build tools, etc.

### How to go about solving infra issues?

- Contractual agreement with a dev-ops firm or consultant may help mitigate risk - infra work has to be done by trusted parties
  - Work is too great to be done by one party
  - **ACTION ITEM:** Jory to discuss probable resource request with Robin/Brian
- Start with Core, which is at greatest risk
  - Look at the workloads of the servers - infra inventory is fairly complete
- Determine “What’s Frozen” vs. “What evolves”
  - What’s the list of things Core needs?
  - **ACTION ITEM:** Adam & Michal to start creating that list; document on /infra GH

### Key Issues

- Separation of Core & UI/Mobile/other projects
  - Still need to keep other projects secure in some way
  - Detach some of it from the infra (static wordpress for example)
  - Keep trac in read-only mode
- Long-term Maintenance & Security
- Port builds/test infra to Travis - this can happen now
- Does Core want to keep the CLA?
