The death penalty disrupts that and acts as the ultimate rejection of a belief that God can change people, whether that be the person who brought the harm or those who were harmed.

We believe in a God who can redeem and heal, even from the most chaotic and confusing of situations. We ourselves worship an arrested, tried, and executed Savior. And we worship a risen Lord who has conquered death by his own death on the cross.

We now live in the light of Jesus' life, and so we can and must reject state-sponsored death exacted in our name.
