



# **Student Guide**

#### Create an account

1. To make an account, go to **skillblox.org**. Then, click the **Sign Up!** button on the top right corner of your screen.



2. Next, you will be given two options for creating an account. Let's walk through both.



#### **Option 1: Enter Your Information**

- Enter your information on the left side of the screen. If you create your account this way, write down your username and password so you don't forget them.
- When you're done, click the Sign Up button. DO NOT close your browser yet! You need to check your email for a code.
- Open your email inbox and find the email from SkillBlox. Copy the six-digit code from your email.
- Go back to SkillBlox, paste the code in the Verification box, and click the Verify Account button.


#### **Option 2: Use Your Google Account**

- If you have a Google account, you can use it to make a SkillBlox account. With this option, you don't have to remember a new user name or password.
- To sign up with Google, enter your Google login information, then confirm that you are OK with Google sharing your basic information with SkillBlox.
- Once you click OK, you can log in to SkillBlox! From now on, you only need your Google login information to sign into SkillBlox.

3. Select Your Account Type: When you sign into SkillBlox with your new account for the first time, you need to select if you are *an instructor user* (*teacher*) or a *student user*. **This choice cannot be undone**, so please be careful to select the correct option.




4. After selecting your user type, you're done! You will see a confirmation screen with your SkillBlox username. If you entered your information to make an account, you will see the username you created. If you made your account with Google, a username will be assigned to you. If you want to change your username, you can update it in your account settings.



### Saving to My SkillBlox

#### **Option 1: Save from an Open Blox**


1. Open a Blox using a code or URL shared by your teacher.



2. To use SkillBlox to learn, you should save it to track your progress! To save the Blox, click the **pink save icon**.




3. If you are not already logged into SkillBlox, you will be prompted to **sign in** to save the Blox to your account.



# Option 2: Add Blox by URL or Code


1. Open your SkillBlox homepage.



2. Click + Add SkillBlox.



3. Enter the SkillBlox code or URL your teacher gave you.




4. Click **ADD SKILLBLOX** to finish adding it to My SkillBlox.


# **ADD TO MY SKILLBLOX**

## Launch an activity


1. Open a SkillBlox from your dashboard or using a link from your teacher. You can do this by clicking on the **SkillBlox Name**.




2. Click the green Launch button on an activity to start it!



3. If you don't finish an activity after starting it, you can click the **blue Resume button** to go back to it later




4. Once you've completed an activity, you can review it later by clicking on the dark blue Review button.




#### Marking activities complete


1. Open a Blox.



2. Click or hover over the gray check box next to an activity.




3. Once you have completed an activity, click the **I'm done!** button with the **green check mark** above it.




# Providing activity feedback


1. Open a Blox.



2. Mark an activity as complete. Not sure how? <u>Learn more here</u>.



- 3. Provide feedback about how much time you spent on the activity, if you liked the activity, if the activity was easy to use, and if it helped you learn. The purpose of this feedback is to help others understand how helpful the activity is and how long it took you to complete, so please be as honest and use your best estimates when answering.
  - a. Use the + and buttons to change the amount of time you spent
  - b. Use the **thumbs up** and **thumbs down** buttons to say if you liked the activity or not
  - c. Use the **colorful faces** to say if the activity was easy to use with **green** meaning it was easy and red meaning it was hard.
  - d. Use the **colorful faces** to say if the activity helped you learn with green meaning it helped you and red meaning it did not help you.



4. Once you've given your feedback, click the **Submit** button.




5. If you don't want to provide feedback, you can click the **Maybe Later** button.

# Viewing your progress

1. Open your SkillBlox homepage.



- 2. Check your status under the **Progress** area.
  - a. When a Blox is in progress: You will see a yellow dotted check to the left of the Blox Name and a blue progress bar indicating the number of activities you've completed so far.
  - b. When a Blox is not started: You will see a **blank space** to the left of the Blox Name and **a gray progress bar** indicating zero (0) activities within the Blox have been completed
  - c. When a Blox is completed: You will see a **full green check** to the left of the Blox Name and the **progress bar will be green** and indicate that all activities in the Blox have been completed.
