Thank you for your generous support of my recent medical mission to Ghana, Africa. Because of your donations, our multidisciplinary team provided care to patients in Kukuom, Goaso, and surrounding communities over five intense days. Our team included plastic surgeons, an ENT surgeon, a family physician, nurse practitioners, nurses, and dedicated non-medical volunteers working side by side to meet overwhelming needs. Your contributions directly funded thousands of dollars in critical medical and surgical supplies, which allowed us to care for patients who otherwise would have had no access to these services.

During this mission, we performed dozens of complex and life-changing surgeries – ranging from reconstructive procedures, hernia repairs, tumor and keloid excisions, thyroid and head-and-neck surgeries and pediatric cases, to treatments that restored dignity, function, and hope. In parallel, our outreach team visited schools, villages, and an orphanage to provide physical assessments, treatment, education, and supplies while also supporting mothers' and children's hospital wards. I had the honor of serving with HART, a nonprofit led by Dr. Kimball Crofts, whose more than 20 years of global service exemplify compassion in action. Your generosity made it possible for healing to reach far beyond the operating room, and I am profoundly grateful for your partnership in this sacred work of service.
