Parents please register your child for the best fitted swimming level. The pool staff will evaluate the students on the first day and may move them to the class that will work the best for their skill level. If you wish to have semi-private (family lessons) please contact the Community Ed Office directly. Limited locker room usage is available, but if you can come dressed ready for swimming, that is appreciated. **YOU MUST SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL.** Current MN guidance for pools will be followed during lessons.

Class Descriptions

(PSPT) Parents/Tots, (6 months - 6 years) – Parents must accompany their child in the water. Bring your child and let them get acquainted with the water. Learn the proper hold for your child in the water and play lots of fun water games. The Pool temp is set at 83 degrees but, please bring a t-shirt along with for your child to wear if the pool feels cooler.
(PS 1) Level 1 – Water Exploration (4-6 years) -Child will learn to enter/ exit water on own, blow bubbles, fully submerge face, and experience supported floating and kicking.
(PS 2 & 3) Level 2 – Learn Primary Skills (4 – 6 years) -Learn to float without support and recover to a vertical position. Front and back glides are introduced. PS3 -Learn to change direction, combine arm & leg actions on both front & back.

RC – American Red Cross Levels (Ages 6 & up) -

- Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills: Students will learn how to feel comfortable in the water and safely enjoy it.
- Level 2: Fundamentals of Aquatic Skills: Children will learn basic swimming skills.
- Level 3: Stroke Development: Additional guided practice will help students improve their skills.
- Level 4: Stroke Improvement: Kids will gain confidence during swim lessons, improve their stroke and gain additional aquatic skills.
- Level 5: Stroke Refinement: Guidance allows kids to refine their strokes and become more efficient swimmers.
- Level 6: Swimming and Skill Proficiency: Students will learn to swim with ease and efficiency, and gain the ability to swim smoothly over greater distances. Swimmers will also have the option to participate in more advanced courses.
