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Mr. President,
Mr. Chancellor,

We the undersigned are academics from various countries who have long been working with colleagues in the United States, at the University of California, and in particular at Berkeley.

We just found out in *The Guardian* that UC Berkeley has notified 160 faculty members and students that their names have been given to the Trump administration for an investigation into “alleged antisemitic incidents.”

We are truly concerned.

We are aware that the University has an obligation to comply with federal investigations. However, we believe that universities also have obligations to their faculty and students, who undeniably have both academic and political rights. Indeed, to preserve their institutional autonomy, some University presidents in the US have refused to comply with federal demands that they consider illegitimate.

A spokesperson for the university is quoted saying: “We are committed to transparency.” However, transparency should work both ways. Whatever reason UC Berkeley might have for acquiescing in federal investigations instead of refusing to comply, it goes against the principle of transparency to notify people that their names have been forwarded to the administration without communicating the content and nature of the allegations to the persons thus exposed. This looks like a one-way mirror.

One consequence is that the people thus denounced have not had a chance to dispute the information the university has collected.

Universities have a duty to fight for academic freedom. Of course, today, they are under attack. But this is precisely the moment when the defense of academic freedom is most necessary.

We have always admired those who, at Berkeley and elsewhere, fight for this fundamental liberty – not just free speech, but academic freedom. This is an essential value in democratic societies, all the more so when it is under threat.

We look forward to continuing the free exchange of ideas with colleagues at UC Berkeley and beyond, and thus strongly urge you to (re)assure us that we still share these values.

Version française :

Monsieur le Président,

Monsieur le Recteur,

Nous, signataires de cette lettre, sommes des universitaires de différents pays qui travaillons depuis longtemps avec des collègues aux États-Unis, à l'université de Californie, et en particulier à Berkeley.

Nous venons d'apprendre dans *The Guardian* que l'université de Californie à Berkeley avait annoncé à cent soixante étudiant·es et membres du corps enseignant que leurs noms avaient été communiqués à l'administration Trump dans le cadre d'une enquête sur des « incidents antisémites présumés ».

C'est vraiment pour nous une source d'inquiétude.

Nous avons bien conscience que l'UC a l'obligation de se plier aux enquêtes fédérales. Cependant, nous pensons que les universités ont également des obligations envers leurs professeur·es et leurs étudiant·es, qui ont indéniablement des droits, tant académiques que politiques. De fait, il est des président·es d'université qui, afin de préserver l'autonomie de leur institution, ont refusé de se conformer à ces demandes jugées illégitimes.

Une porte-parole de l'université de Berkeley affirme dans l'article : « Nous nous engageons à faire preuve de transparence ». Cependant, la transparence doit fonctionner dans les deux sens. Quelle que soit la raison pour laquelle l'université de Berkeley a accepté de se soumettre aux enquêtes fédérales au lieu de refuser de s'y conformer, le fait d'informer les personnes concernées que leur nom a été transmis à l'administration sans leur communiquer le contenu et la nature des allégations contredit le principe de transparence. C'est comme un miroir sans tain. L'une des conséquences est que les personnes ainsi dénoncées n'ont pas eu la possibilité de contester les informations recueillies par l'université.

Les universités ont le devoir de lutter pour la liberté académique. Bien sûr, elles sont aujourd'hui attaquées. Mais c'est précisément le moment où la défense de la liberté académique est le plus nécessaire.

Nous avons toujours admiré celles et ceux qui, à Berkeley et ailleurs, luttent pour cette liberté fondamentale – non seulement la liberté d’expression, mais aussi la liberté académique. Il s’agit d’une valeur essentielle dans des sociétés démocratiques, d’autant plus lorsqu’elle est menacée.

Nous souhaitons poursuivre le libre-échange d’idées avec nos collègues de l’université de Berkeley et au-delà, et nous vous demandons donc instamment de nous (r)assurer que nous partageons bien toujours ces valeurs.

Versión en Español

Señor presidente,
Señor rector,

Los abajo firmantes somos académicxs de diversos países que llevamos mucho tiempo trabajando con colegas de Estados Unidos, de la Universidad de California y, en particular, de Berkeley.

Acabamos de enterarnos por The Guardian de que la Universidad de California en Berkeley ha notificado a 160 miembros del cuerpo docente y estudiantes que sus nombres han sido transmitidos a la administración Trump para que se investiguen «presuntos incidentes antisemitas».

Estamos verdaderamente preocupados.

Somos conscientes de que la Universidad tiene la obligación de cooperar con las investigaciones federales. Sin embargo, creemos que las universidades también tienen obligaciones con su profesorado y sus estudiantes, quienes indudablemente tienen derechos tanto académicos como políticos. De hecho, para preservar su autonomía institucional, algunos rectores de universidades estadounidenses se han negado a cumplir con las exigencias federales que consideran ilegítimas.

Un portavoz de la universidad ha declarado: «Estamos comprometidos con la transparencia». Sin embargo, la transparencia debe funcionar en ambos sentidos. Sea cual sea la razón que tenga la Universidad de California en Berkeley para aceptar las investigaciones federales y no negarse a cumplirlas, notificar a las personas que sus nombres han sido remitidos a la administración sin comunicarles el contenido y la naturaleza de las alegaciones hechas va en contra del principio de transparencia. Esto parece un espejo unidireccional. Una de las consecuencias es que las personas denunciadas no han tenido la oportunidad de rebatir la información que la universidad ha recopilado.

Las universidades tienen el deber de luchar por la libertad académica. Por supuesto, hoy en día están siendo atacadas. Pero este es precisamente el momento en el que la defensa de la libertad académica es más necesaria.

Siempre hemos admirado a quienes, en Berkeley y en otros lugares, luchan por esta libertad fundamental, no solo por la libertad de expresión, sino también por la libertad académica. Se trata de un valor esencial en las sociedades democráticas, más aún cuando se ve amenazado.

Esperamos continuar con el libre intercambio de ideas con nuestros colegas de la Universidad de California en Berkeley y más allá, por lo que le instamos encarecidamente a que nos (re)asegure que seguimos compartiendo estos valores.

Versione italiana

Egregio Presidente,
Magnifico Rettore,

Noi sottoscritti, universitari provenienti da vari paesi, collaboriamo da tempo con colleghi negli Stati Uniti, con l'Università della California e in particolare con Berkeley.

Abbiamo appena saputo dal quotidiano *The Guardian* che l'Università della California a Berkeley ha informato centosessanta membri del suo corpo docente e dei suoi studenti che i loro nomi erano stati trasmessi all'amministrazione Trump nell'ambito di un'indagine su "presunti episodi di antisemitismo".

Ne siamo estremamente preoccupati.

Ovviamente siamo consapevoli che l'Università ha l'obbligo di collaborare alle indagini federali. Tuttavia, riteniamo che le università abbiano anche degli obblighi nei confronti dei loro docenti e studenti, che a loro volta hanno innegabilmente diritti sia accademici che politici. Ora, per preservare la loro autonomia istituzionale, alcuni rettori universitari negli Stati Uniti si sono precisamente rifiutati di ottemperare alle richieste federali che ritengono illegittime.

Un portavoce dell'università ha dichiarato: "Ci impegniamo a garantire la trasparenza". Certo, ma la trasparenza deve funzionare in entrambe le direzioni. Qualunque sia la ragione per cui l'Università di Berkeley ha acconsentito alle indagini federali invece di rifiutarsi di collaborare, il fatto di non notificare alle persone i cui nomi sono stati trasmessi all'amministrazione il contenuto e la natura delle accuse portate contro di loro è contrario al principio di trasparenza, come stare davanti ad uno specchio senza vetro. La conseguenza immediata è che le persone così denunciate non hanno avuto la possibilità di esaminare e contestare le informazioni raccolte dall'università.

Le università hanno il dovere di lottare per difendere le libertà accademiche. Oggi, esse sono sotto attacco. Proprio per questa ragione, la difesa delle libertà accademiche è oggi più necessaria che mai.

Abbiamo sempre ammirato coloro che, a Berkeley e altrove, lottano per queste libertà fondamentali - non solo la libertà di espressione ma anche le libertà accademiche. Si tratta di un valore essenziale per le società democratiche, tanto più se viene minacciato.

Vogliamo continuare a scambiare liberamente idee con i colleghi dell'Università della California a Berkeley, così come con tutte le altre università, e vi chiediamo pertanto di (r)assicurarci sul fatto che condividiamo ancora questi valori.

Senhor Presidente,
Senhor Chanceler,

Nós, abaixo assinados, somos acadêmicas/os/es de vários países que há muito tempo trabalhamos com colegas nos Estados Unidos, na Universidade da Califórnia e, em particular, em Berkeley.

Acabamos de saber pelo The Guardian que a UC Berkeley notificou 160 membros do corpo docente e estudantes de que os seus nomes foram entregues à administração Trump para uma investigação sobre «supostos incidentes antissemitas».

Estamos verdadeiramente preocupados.

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Estamos cientes de que a Universidade tem a obrigação de cooperar com as investigações federais. No entanto, acreditamos que as universidades também têm obrigações para com seus professores e alunos, que inegavelmente têm direitos acadêmicos e políticos. De fato, para preservar sua autonomia institucional, alguns reitores de universidades nos Estados Unidos se recusaram a cumprir exigências federais que consideram ilegítimas.

Um porta-voz da universidade foi citado dizendo: “Estamos comprometidos com a transparência”. No entanto, a transparência deve funcionar nos dois sentidos. Qualquer que seja a razão que a UC Berkeley possa ter para aceitar as investigações federais e não se recusar a cumpri-las, é contrário ao princípio da transparência notificar as pessoas de que seus nomes foram encaminhados à administração sem comunicar o conteúdo e a natureza das alegações atribuídas às pessoas assim expostas. Isso parece um espelho unidirecional. Uma consequência disso é que as pessoas assim denunciadas não tiveram a chance de contestar as informações coletadas pela universidade.

As universidades têm o dever de lutar pela liberdade acadêmica. É claro que, hoje, elas estão sob ataque. Mas este é precisamente o momento em que a defesa da liberdade acadêmica é mais necessária.

Sempre admiramos aqueles que, em Berkeley e em outros lugares, lutam por essa liberdade fundamental – não apenas a liberdade de expressão, mas a liberdade acadêmica. Esse é um valor essencial nas sociedades democráticas, ainda mais quando está sob ameaça.

Esperamos continuar a livre troca de ideias com colegas da UC Berkeley e de outras instituições e, portanto, pedimos veementemente que nos (re)assegurem de que ainda compartilhamos esses valores.

Verzija na srpskom:

Gospodine predsedniče,
Gospodine rektore,

Mi, dolepotpisani, akademski smo radnici iz različitih zemalja koji dugo radimo s kolegincima i kolegama iz Sjedinjenih Država, sa Univerziteta u Kaliforniji i posebno sa Berklija.

Upravo smo iz *Gardijana* saznali da je kalifornijski Univerzitet Berkli obavestio 160 članova univerziteta i studenata da su njihova imena predata Trampovoj administraciji radi istrage o „navodnim antisemitskim incidentima“.

Iskreno smo zabrinuti.

Svesni smo da Univerzitet ima obavezu da odgovori na zahtev za federalnom istragom. Međutim, verujemo da univerziteti imaju obaveze i prema svom osoblju i studentima, koji nesporno imaju i akademska i politička prava. Da bi se očuvala institucionalna autonomija, neki predsednici univerziteta u SAD su odbili da odgovore na federalne zahteve koje smatraju nelegitimnima.

Navedene su reči portparola univerziteta: „Posvećeni smo transparentnosti“. No, transparentnost treba da bude dvosmerna. Kakvi god da su bili razlozi na temelju kojih je UC Berkli pristao na federalnu istragu umesto da je odbije, obaveštenje ljudi da su im imena prosleđena administraciji a da se pre toga s njima nije komuniciralo o sadržaju i prirodi navoda o njihovim aktivnostima, u suprotnosti je s načelom transparentnosti. Ovaj gest je vrlo jednosmeran. Jedna od njegovih posledica je da ovako prokaženi ljudi nisu dobili priliku da ospore informacije koje je univerzitet o njima prikupio.

Univerziteti imaju dužnost da se bore za akademsku slobodu. Naravno, oni su danas na udaru. Upravo je to, međutim, trenutak kada je odbrana akademske slobode najneophodnija.

Uvek smo se divili onima koji se, na Berkliju i drugde, bore za tu fundamentalnu slobodu – ne samo za slobodan govor, već za akademsku slobodu. To je suštinska vrednost u demokratskim društvima, još i više kada je ugrožena.

Radujemo se nastavku slobodne razmene ideja s kolegama i koleginicama na Univerzitetu Berkli, i dalje, i stoga Vas snažno pozivamo da nas (raz)uverite da i dalje delimo ove vrednosti.
