Executive Board Reports

Scott Pulliam -- Treasurer

Very nice results from BINGO Night: \$1,000, Concessions \$3800, Auction \$14,200.

For the year expenses: \$6500, about \$6,000 left to spend. We will round out at about \$13,000 for the year, so there is money to spend this year.

The possibility of a track has been a suggestion from the administration. Mr. McRae has started getting estimates.

Ms. Malkowski mentioned that he has been talking and getting quotes. It's \$20,000-\$25,000 for a track.

The fifth graders are at \$2400 including the matching for the field trip. This is comparable to last year, which brought the total down to around \$45 per child (without assistance from PTA it costs \$80/child).

Ms. Nealon would like to spend \$500 to do a unit on growing organic food, including a horticulturist and a salad party. \$500.00 covers the lessons over three days and all supplies. This could be added as a teacher grant and expanding teacher grants. Grant applications will go out soon to teachers and will be due by the end of March.
