

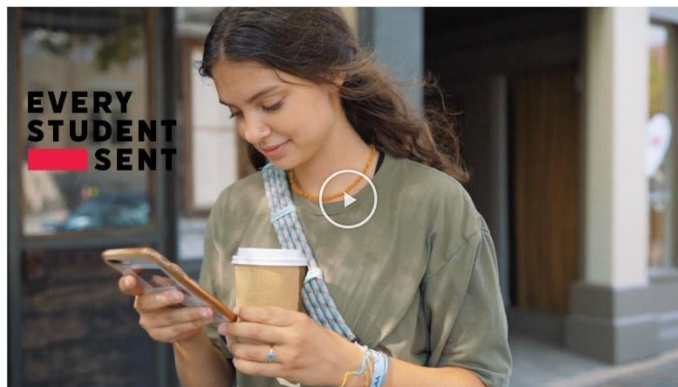
To Our Parents,

Here are some of the things that you can do as a parent to help your student leverage the Every Student Sent platform:

Sign Up for Every Student Sent

Every Student Sent is a platform for students, but that doesn't mean parents can't help! Simply create a parent account for the Every Student Sent platform to get started, and will walk you through the process of getting your college-bound or college-aged child connected.

Invite Your Students

Once you've created an account, the next step is to invite students to the Every Student Sent platform. This is all done within the Every Student Sent platform, and simply requires having basic contact information for who you want to invite like emails or cell phone numbers. 10-12th grade students will enjoy the videos under "Courses".

Help your Junior and Senior select colleges with good ministries and churches. They can message leaders and connect online in a group of other incoming Christian students.
