- 1022 lines of data total. 951 for the year 2013 only. (Everything else will be 2013 only)
- 185 names, so 185 with take home cars filed for overtime?

Total call backs: 951.Total hours: 5777


Questions

- Since all the people listed in this data have at least 1 call back, do we have everyone with cars? i.e., could there be people with cars that never filed for overtime/comp time so that aren't on this list?
- When they were assigned the car might matter. If they got the car in December and had only one call ...

Call backs (or overtime/comp time charges)

So, there are 38 people who have filed overtime/comp time only once ... that's 20% of the total names listed. (There are 185 names on this list. If there are people who have cars but never got overtime, percentages could change.) 42% have been filed 3 or fewer times (once a quarter on average). 63% were called back 5 times or less, so less than once every two months on average. 67 people -- or 36% of the total – filed for time on average at least once a month.

Those numbers come from this chart that shows how many people filed for overtime a certain number of times. So, 38 people were called back/filed only once. Forty people were called back 2 or 3 times, etc.
