- 1. **Draft Minutes** of the committee's October 22nd meeting were reviewed and approved.

3. Discussion:

A. Act 73/Redistricting Update:

The State's Redistricting Task Force chose not to move forward with a draft map that would have placed Cabot into a merged "Supervisory District" comprised of students from the schools in Barre, Montpelier, Twinfield and the U-32 and Harwood school districts and governed by a single school board. The Legislature will make the final decision on how school districts will be organized when it reconvenes in January.

B. Planning for this year: building value in the community for Cabot School

Shannon shared that increasing the amount of housing in Cabot would have many benefits, including increasing the number of students at Cabot School. Discussion ensued about current obstacles: High cost of new construction, challenging permitting process, and large number of pay-with-cash buyers.

Discussion next on three specific ways to build value this year:

I. Make home-school families aware of Cabot School offerings

a. Value: *increased confidence/familiarity with Cabot School

*Increased learning opportunities for both home-school and Cabot School students *Potential for increased enrollment

b. Making it happen:

*Contact Jackie Batten for menu of HS/MS project studios for Sem. II, and daily schedule of core classes/specials in Elementary grades

*Article describing opportunities/process for Cabot Chronicle and FPF (Chris) in the next month

II. Increase number of volunteers coming into school to share expertise

a. Goal: List of interested volunteers and their skills/experience that teachers can tap into when planning units

b. Value: * enhance learning

*broaden students' perspectives: potential careers

*Increase connection/understanding of school

c. Getting there:

- Nail down logistics of visitors in school: Criminal background checks (check w/Jenn Tidd)
- * Intro article asking for volunteers in FPF, Cabot Connects, and Cabot Chronicle (Chris and Shannon: draft for next meeting) * Stef: phone connections

B. Value:
