

Privacy Policy

1. Who We Are

Space Raccoon Games LLC ("we", "us", or "our") operates the landing page and email subscription service. We are established in Armenia at the following address: apt.35, 43 Gyulbenkyan Street, 0033 Yerevan.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard personal information when you visit our landing page and subscribe to our email list.

2. Scope

This Privacy Policy applies to personal information collected through our landing page and email subscription form. Users may find links on our landing page to our other products or websites; those properties are governed by their own privacy policies.

3. Information We Collect

We collect the following categories of information:

- Identifiers: your email address (when you subscribe).
- Internet or other electronic network activity information: basic technical information automatically sent by your browser as part of requests to our site and security tooling (e.g., IP address and user agent processed by anti-spam protections).
- Information related to child users: if a child under 13 submits information, we will obtain verifiable parental consent before collection or delete the information if consent cannot be obtained (see Children's Privacy section).

4. How We Collect Information

We collect information in the following ways:

- Directly from you when you enter and submit your email address to subscribe.
- Automatically through security tooling used to protect our forms from spam and abuse (Google Invisible reCAPTCHA). We do not use analytics or tracking tools for advertising or behavioral profiling.

5. What We Do NOT Do

- We do not use analytics or tracking tools for advertising or behavioral profiling.
- We do not show ads on the landing page.
- We do not accept payments on the landing page (although links to our products may be present).
- We do not use remarketing services for marketing or advertising purposes.

6. How We Use Your Information and Legal Bases (GDPR)

We use your information for the following purposes and under the following legal bases under the EU/UK GDPR:

- To send you email updates and newsletters you requested — Legal basis: Consent (GDPR Art. 6(1)(a)).
- To operate, secure, and protect our services, including preventing spam and abuse (reCAPTCHA) — Legal basis: Legitimate interests (GDPR Art. 6(1)(f)).
- To comply with legal obligations — Legal basis: Legal obligation (GDPR Art. 6(1)(c)), where applicable.

7. Email Service Provider

We use Sender to manage and send our email communications. Sender acts as our data processor/service provider for these purposes. You can review Sender's privacy policy here: <https://www.sender.net/privacy-policy/>.

8. Google Invisible reCAPTCHA

We use Google Invisible reCAPTCHA to help prevent spam and abuse on our forms. The use of reCAPTCHA is subject to the Google Privacy Policy (<https://policies.google.com/privacy>) and Terms of Service (<https://policies.google.com/terms>). reCAPTCHA analyzes certain technical information solely for security purposes.

9. Disclosure of Information

We disclose personal information only as follows:

- Service providers/processors: to vendors that help us deliver our services (e.g., Sender, Google reCAPTCHA).
- Legal and compliance: when required to comply with law, enforce our terms, or protect rights, privacy, safety, or property.
- Business transfers: in the event of a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, subject to this Policy and applicable law.

We do not sell or share your personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising as defined under the CPRA.

10. Data Retention

We retain your email address for as long as you remain subscribed and for a reasonable period thereafter to comply with legal obligations or resolve disputes. We will delete or anonymize information when it is no longer needed for the purposes described above.

11. Data Security

We implement reasonable technical and organizational measures designed to protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. However, no method of transmission over the internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure.

12. International Data Transfers

Space Raccoon Games LLC is located in Armenia. Your information may be processed in, or transferred to, other countries (including the European Union or the United States) by our service providers. Where required, we use appropriate safeguards for international transfers, such as standard contractual clauses, and rely on our processors' documented compliance measures.

13. Your Choices

You have the following choices regarding your information:

- Unsubscribe: You can unsubscribe from our emails using the link in any email we send.
- Consent withdrawal: Where processing is based on consent, you can withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing before withdrawal.

14. Rights of Individuals in the EEA/UK (GDPR)

Subject to conditions and exceptions under the GDPR, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data and receive a copy.
- Request rectification of inaccurate or incomplete data.
- Request erasure ("right to be forgotten").
- Request restriction of processing.
- Object to processing based on legitimate interests.
- Data portability, where technically feasible.
- Lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in your country of residence or work, or where an alleged infringement took place.

15. California Notice (CCPA/CPRA)

For California residents, we provide the following additional disclosures:

- Categories collected: Identifiers (email address); Internet or other electronic network activity information related to security features (e.g., IP address/user agent processed by reCAPTCHA).
- Sources: Directly from you; automatically via security tools.
- Business purposes: Providing the service you request (emails/newsletters); detecting and preventing security incidents; debugging; complying with law.

- Disclosure for a business purpose: to service providers (e.g., MailerLite, Google) solely to support our services.

We do not sell your personal information and do not share it for cross-context behavioral advertising. We do not use or disclose sensitive personal information for purposes other than those permitted by the CPRA.

California rights include:

- Right to know/access the personal information we collect, use, disclose, and retain about you.
- Right to delete personal information, subject to exceptions.
- Right to correct inaccurate personal information.
- Right to opt out of sale or sharing of personal information (not applicable as we do not sell/share as defined).
- Right to non-discrimination for exercising your privacy rights.
- Use of an authorized agent to submit requests, subject to verification.

16. California Online Privacy Protection Act (CalOPPA)

As required by CalOPPA, we disclose the following:

- You can visit our site anonymously.
- This Privacy Policy includes the word "Privacy" and can be accessed from our landing page.
- We honor privacy choices described in this Policy. Currently, we do not respond to Do Not Track (DNT) signals due to a lack of industry standards.
- You can review and request updates to your information by contacting us via our contact form.

17. Children's Privacy (COPPA)

Our services may be accessed by children under 13. We comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13 without verifiable parental consent. If we learn that a child has provided personal information without such consent, we will delete that information unless we obtain consent in a timely manner.

Parents and legal guardians have the right to: (a) review the personal information collected from their child; (b) revoke consent and request deletion; and (c) refuse further collection or use of the child's information. To exercise these rights, please contact us via our contact form.

Operators that may collect persistent identifiers solely to provide the service and for security include Google (reCAPTCHA) and Sender. Such operators' data practices are described in their respective privacy policies referenced in this document.
