
Bowie ISD Elementary Discipline Matrix



Discipline Matrix

The Bowie ISD Secondary Discipline Matrix is a tool that BISD Campus Administrators use to appropriately respond when students have committed behavioral infractions, per the Student Code of Conduct. This tool is designed to provide consistency across the district, ensuring that students are disciplined appropriately from school to school. This matrix is used when student behavior requires consequences beyond the classroom. All student misbehavior occurring on school property, in school transportation, at school events, and in any area within 300 feet of school property may result in consequences. The matrix provides progressive disciplinary actions to address multiple behaviors. These consequences may be categorized as levels of consequences or as steps to be taken based on continued misbehavior. This matrix is a guide for BISD Campus Administrators; however, each administrator has the discretion to deviate from these guidelines when necessary. On these occasions, the administrator must continue assigning fair and appropriate consequences, even when they are not the ones stated in the matrix. This may be handed down if the administrator determines, in their sole discretion, that mitigating or aggravating circumstances exist. Campus Administrators also have the discretion to consider prior behaviors or incidents, or the lack of previous misbehavior, when assigning consequences. For behaviors not listed in the chart below, BISD Campus Administrators will refer to the <u>TEA Chapter 37 Discipline</u> **Chart and TASB Chapter 37 Discipline Chart.**

DAEP placement lengths (listed below) range from 12 days (3 weeks) to 36 days (9 weeks) and progress in three-week increments, depending on the severity of the infraction.

BISD weeks

- 3 weeks = 12 days
- 6 weeks = 24 days
- 9 weeks = 36 day
