

GCSE Spanish – Higher tier

Revision Guide for Feb Mocks 2025

Your mock exams will consist of the following:

1. **A Listening Paper - Higher Tier 45 mins**
2. **A Reading Paper - Higher Tier 1 hour**
3. **A Writing Paper - Higher Tier 1 hour 15 mins**

All exams will include questions on all topics on the syllabus

The best way to revise for languages is by 'doing activities' and here is our advice for revision:

Listening and Reading Papers

1. Look over your notes on each of the topics that we have covered since year 10. Reread any articles/sheets stuck in your book and refamiliarise yourself with the vocabulary you met - building vocabulary is always really important for the listening and reading.

2. Look in both the Foundation and Higher version of the Kerboodle online textbook and read through the chapters on each topic completing any exercises (listenings and readings in particular) ...even if you have done it before, repetition is how you learn!

3. Go onto quizlet and learn/revise any vocab for each theme:
