

The southern hemisphere does show up quite prominently, on the left and right at least, and not the "bottom." This points to the main bias, which is important to understand to get the context of the map. The Dymaxion map is intentionally land-biased (keeping them together and uncut), and in so, may inadvertently minimize the oceans. Pacific islanders may hate this map. You can't tell from this map that there's a view of the earth that's all blue. Different biases for different maps. Globes are the best.
