

(Trudeau and the communist power shift)

1969	Our first communist Liberal Prime Minister Pierre Elliot Trudeau (PET) removed Civics courses from schools, which is the study of rights and obligations in society.
1977	PET began to seize guns by introducing the first gun control laws.
1982	PET introduced the Charter of Rights and Freedoms, which places limits on our inalienable rights and diminishes the opportunity for juries. These rights that were attacked are still recognized and protected under common law and codified law such as the Canadian Bill of Rights.
1989	Right after the signing of the first Free Trade Agreement, the provinces introduced unconstitutional Statute Courts, which do not have authority to recognize common law or codified rights, including bail and jury. These courts are unconstitutional, but they have not yet been challenged.
2016	Right after coming to power, our second communist Liberal Prime Minister Justin Trudeau stepped up the gun control with more outlawing of guns.
2024	An attempt is being made to transfer power from the parliament (representatives of the people) to the courts. This move is now in progress. If it is completed, we are no longer a democratic country because we have lost all power and control of parliament and the courts. Our vote is how we control parliament, and the jury is how we control the court. If parliament no longer has supreme power, then our vote is useless. We have already lost control of the court because we do not have juries.
	If the court makes all the determinations of law, when there is a conflict with the court, there is no independent impartial arbiter. The court was supposed to be the independent impartial arbiter between the people and the state. This works when the jury is the decision maker because they are independent and impartial.
	If the communist power shift is made, our common law rights and codified rights are reduced to privileges that can be taken away by the state at will. Bottom line: our three necessary tools to keep the people in power and control:
	 The Ballot Box, which is gone if we have no control over the parliament. The Jury Box, which is gone if we have no control over the courts. The Cartridge Box, which is under attack if they confiscate all the guns.
