



Music NCEA Level 2 & 3

Course Description:

Music NCEA Level 2 and 3 courses both offer a well-balanced range of musical skills which cover the three most important aspects of music; performance, composition and theory knowledge. This course aims to develop the student's ability to practice their instrument effectively, boost performance confidence, expand their level of musical creativity and imagination through composition, all while providing a solid foundation of theory knowledge.

Content

Topics covered include:

- **Performance skills:** How to prepare, rehearse, interpret, present, and evaluate sustained performances of music individually and collaboratively, demonstrating interpretive understandings
- **Composition skills:** How to create, structure, refine and represent compositions using secure technical and musical skills and technologies to express imaginative thinking and personal understandings. This includes a reflection on your creative processes and presentation conventions
- **Theoretical knowledge:** How to analyse, apply and evaluate significant expressive features and stylistic conventions in a range of music using theoretical skills
- **Understanding the Arts in context:** How to research, analyse and evaluate the production and presentation of music works from historical, social, and cultural contexts.

Prior Learning Required

- Learnt a musical instrument (which includes voice) and music theory for at least four years and preferably have completed the Year 11 or 12 programme already in place
- However, a student with a high practical and/or theoretical base could enter the course at this level

- Access to preferred DAW, i.e. Garageband, Logic, Sibelius etc.
