

Where are your taxes going?

“The Big Beautiful Bill”

INCREASES

New tax provisions that favor the top 20% of households. (Costing \$4.6 trillion over the next 10 years).

\$70 billion on border security and deportations.

\$150 billion increases on defense spending.

REGULATION CHANGES

Judges can no longer punish federal officials for disobeying court orders unless the person suing them pays a financial bond first.

10-year federal moratorium (prohibition) on state and local AI regulations.

! NOTE

This bill is projected to add between \$3.8 trillion and \$5.1 trillion to the national debt over the next decade.

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CUTS

\$880 billion from Medicaid over 10 years. (Est. 8.6 million people could lose health insurance.)

Some tax provisions for middle and lower-income people end.

\$267 billion from SNAP.

Federal reserve allocation for CPB (NPR & PBS) from 12% to 5%.

Approximately \$26.7 billion in housing assistance.

\$646 million in funding for disaster relief (FEMA).

Terminates tax credits for renewable energy projects after 2025.

Eliminates subsidized federal student loans and caps undergrad borrowing at \$50k
