3 Preambulatory Phrases (look at the Resolution Directions)

- *Noting with deep concern* that on average, 55 million people worldwide are impacted by flooding each year,
- *Fully aware* that floodwaters and debris can cause structural damage to bridges and roadways which can make travel extremely difficult,
- *Keeping in mind* that floods and high amounts of rainfall can lead to soil erosion leading to a decline in crop production,

## 5 Operations Phrases

- Requests for drainage systems to be investigated and improved to prevent major flooding
- Encourages plantation of vegetation be more widespread
- Asks for assistance from international countries to support southeast asian countries on their flooding crisis
- Recommends building more flood proof infrastructure
- *Considers* increasing the amount of flood control structure
