Objective:

We want to see how you think through user problems, approach technical decisions, and take initiative. This is meant to simulate the kind of scrappy, real-world work we do daily — not something you can typically answer by asking Google or ChatGPT.

You're joining an early-stage AI startup building autonomous tools for founders and teams. Our goal: help them automate tedious business tasks using AI agents.

1. Field Research (45–60 min)

Talk to a founder or business owner (can be a friend, relative, or someone in your network).

- Understand their business and how it makes money (important)
- What are the critical elements of value generation process
- What is value being generated for customers (for which they pay)

Summarize what you learned in your own words. Include a quote or screenshot if possible.

2. Define a Use Case (30 min) for AI to solve (related to above research). We need to understand how you do problem solving for a business.

Deep dive in the value generation process and see if you can find a use case that can be solved using AI (don't force fit). Tell us:

- Why it's worth solving (should have an economic/money making rationale)
- What a great outcome would look like for that user
- Do other products exist for the same problem - if yes how can this be different?
