Dear Families and students of the class of 2026,

I am pleased to introduce an exciting opportunity for eligible seniors: the Senior Project. This initiative allows students to engage in a community-benefitting activity from May 18th to May 29th in place of attending regular classes during this time.

The goal of this letter is to provide you with the details of the program so that you can make an informed decision regarding your student's participation. The Senior Project allows eligible seniors to choose a project that aligns with their interests and creates a positive impact in the community. The possibilities are endless and have included trail clean-ups, fundraisers, working with nonprofits, or supporting a cause the student feels passionate about. The project requires a total of 40 hours, which must be completed between May 18th and May 29th. With prior approval, exceptions to the dates and times may be granted.

It is the student's responsibility to identify a community project and submit it for approval by April 17th via the Senior Project Proposal available on the RSU #21 website. Pre-arranged projects are also available on a first-come, first served basis and accessible for sign-up on the website.

Seniors who do not participate in the Senior Project must attend school and be present in their classes during the project period, following regular school rules. Participation in the Senior Project is not compensated, and the time cannot be applied toward community service hours. The project cannot be completed with a family member or relative.

If your student is involved in extracurricular activities or sports, they are expected to continue practicing and attending those activities. The Senior Project should not interfere with these commitments.
