### **Statement on Advertisements**

Today, the Zippy for Congress campaign released advertisements in various forms outlining Zippy's plans on various different types of transportation around New Jersey. The advertisements, and a brief description of them, are as follows.

#### **Advertisement 1: Billboard on Tolls**

During his time in congress, Zippy introduced the [American Roadway Toll System Act/ARTSA \(HR.967\)](#). This act creates a nationalized toll network in the US, and makes a majority of toll money go to fixing roads, and to create green transportation, such as eco-friendly light rails and trains.
