Criteria For Selection:

- Nominee must have been an educator in the Indianola Community Schools for a minimum of 10 years and retired from education.
- Nominee must have attained a level of performance by demonstrating a caring attitude for students, superior professional educational teaching skills, and being highly respected by the students and community.
- Nominations must be submitted to the committee in writing, with documentation as to why the nominee should be selected. Nominations must be submitted by February 1.
- All nominations will remain active for three (3) years. If the nominee is not selected during this time their name will be placed on the inactive nomination list. Individuals may be nominated more than once, and will be added to the list for a three year period starting with the date of the last nomination.
- Nominees must receive a simple majority + 1 vote of the committee members present at the meeting to be selected. The vote will be by a confidential written ballot.
- There will be a maximum of two inductees each year including the past graduates.
- The committee reserves the right to modify the selection protocol as agreed upon by the majority of the committee members and make selections at their discretion.
