If your tamariki is interested in playing netball for our Ridgway School team please complete the registration form by Thursday 10 February 2022 . Summary of the programme below:

Year 3 & 4 Programme

Year 3 & 4's play a modified version of the game (5 v 5) over two thirds of a netball court using a size 4 netball and 2.6 metre goals. A portable goal will be used at one end. Girls and boys can play. Positions are 2 x Attacker, 2 x Defender, 1 x Centre, with the court split into halves. MK will provide all resources for the programme, including Junior Co-ordinators to lead the programme, and all equipment (including balls and bibs).

Each weekly session is 60 minutes long and incorporates both a skill development period and a game of approximately 4 x 6 minute quarters. There are five players from each team on the court. Teams may use rolling substitutions at any time during the game.

If there are more than 16 teams, two rounds will be necessary. Once registrations are complete, we will confirm the game times.

Each team registration must be accompanied by at least one Year 3/4 Coach registration. On Game Day (Saturday), Coaches supervise a small group of children under the guidance of the Junior Co-ordinator (provided by MK). Coaches need to attend a Mother Earth futureFERNS training course and be available on Game Day. There is no umpire, but a Junior Co-ordinator or Coach is allowed onto the court to assist and support players during the game.

To Bring on Game Days:

During the Red Level - however there will be restrictions in place.

- 1. Vaccination passes are required to enter the courts for anyone older than 12 year and 3 months. These will be scanned on entry. This will allow us to operate 2 playing sites (Tacy Street site and EBIS Kemp St site).
- 2. For Year 4 and above: Masks are required to be worn on entry and exit, but can be removed while
- 3. Each team that is playing is allowed to have only 10 people enter the courts this includes players and coaches. If your team does not exceed this number, parents can make up the remainder of the 10 allocated places (additional children are included in the allocated 10 places). If teams do not adhere to this request, only coaches/star helpers and players will be able to enter the court area. Please advise your parents prior to registering their child so that it doesn't make it difficult for the MK staff and volunteers.
