Moving to a new school building can be challenging for parents/guardians, and we have designed two evening opportunities to welcome families, provide an overview of our programs, and answer some frequently asked questions. WMS New Parent Information nights are planned from **5:00 pm to 6:15 pm on Tuesday, August 5**<sup>th,</sup> and Thursday, August 7<sup>th</sup> in the WMS Auditorium (attend one). The information nights are scheduled after student schedules are released on Infinite Campus between August 1st and 5th. This meeting is optional but encouraged for new families. Students are welcome to attend, but are not required.

#### WEB (Where Everyone Belongs) Kick-Off Event:

Mark your calendars-- all transitioning 6th-grade students are invited to join the WEB Kick-Off event scheduled for **Tuesday**, **August 19**, **2025**, **from 1:45 to 5:30 PM**. The event is part of our WEB (Where Everyone Belongs) program, and busing will be available. The event will include

WMS staff and roughly 60 trained 8th-grade WEB mentors. The fun and welcoming event will provide incoming students with building tours, mentor connections, guidance, and enthusiasm to start their middle school experience. A light snack will be provided, and students are encouraged to eat lunch before the event. ## 6th Grade Only Open House Night:

We will host the 6th-grade-only open house after the WEB kick-off event from **5:30-7:30 pm on Tuesday, August 19th**. 6th-grade teachers will be on-site to meet students and parents on a night dedicated to incoming students and families. The district-wide open house will take place the following evening on Wednesday, August 20th, from 3:30-7:30. 6th-grade students and families are welcome to come to the open house on Wednesday evening, although most of our 6th-grade staff will only be on-site on Tuesday evening.

## Waconia Middle School Fees:

It may be helpful to be aware of and prepare for school-related annual fees for 6th-grade events and activities. 6th-grade students participate in a unique and traditional overnight learning experience at an environmental learning center. This upcoming year, we will be going to Long Lake Conservation Center (https://www.longlakecc.org/) in Palisade, MN. Half of the students and teachers will attend Oct. 6-8, and the second half will attend Oct. 8-10. When your child attends will be determined by their 6th-grade team. The cost for transportation, food, lodging, additional supervision, and instruction will be approximately \$160.00 per student. Complete and detailed information about the trip will be provided to families in August.

Additional 6th-grade fees will also include asking 6th-grade families to purchase a combination lock from the school at the open house. This procedure started in 2022-23 to benefit students new to using combination locks. The student-owned padlocks will be used in the future for Physical Education lockers when students change clothes for Physical Education in 7th and 8th grade. Our Parent Teacher Organization will be communicating a Fall "One and Done" fundraiser to pay for building-wide "extras" and to provide funding for grade-level field trips
