Superintendent Recommendation

I want to thank Lisa for her work on this. We will continue to look at ways to increase segregation of duties. The identified issue with the Enterprise Fund (Nutrition) is a result of newly adopted accounting regulations. We are required to include future liabilities from retirement (IPERS) in our obligations. I have contacted the Auditor to ensure that we are financially sound in the Enterprise Fund. Please see his comments:

In my opinion and what I tell schools is to look at the School Nutrition Fund, but remove the impact of the IPERS liability. In the case of your District, if I remove the impact of IPERS, your current negative balance of \$53,294 changes to a positive balance of \$75,645, which is a sound financial position.

From your perspective, the cash balance is strong, but the School Nutrition Fund did lose \$9,558 in the last school year, which is why it is important to have cash reserves in place.
