**Grant Opportunities/Updates****OSFM/ODF/USFS**

**OSFM** Grants closed end of January hoping folks put in for that. Strategic investment identified across the state that will benefit the grants process. Plans for Direct Public Assistance for homeowners or other groups for projects. Jen will keep everyone in the loop. OSFM budget is under review, they will be Department of State Fire Marshall, they will get their own budget in July. Keep going with investments from SB762. Clack Fire put in for 4 person crew and chipper.

**ODF** Santiam canyon grants, trying to get more involved with Fire Wise.

**MTH** has been selected as a pilot Forest for Wildfire Crisis Forest, allocated for one year and potential future years especially on this side of the Forest.

**OSU** no funding opportunities at this time, they usually are asking not providing.
