

3/20/24 Meeting Minutes

Allen Road Elementary

- After School Enrichment enrollment began on 3/20 at 6pm, 7 programs in current session
 - o All clubs were asked to sponsor a spot in the program for students with financial hardships, the PTO agreed to match all sponsored donations in each program. Application form available and sponsored positions will be drawn in a lottery on 3/24/24. Parents can also sponsor a spot in a program. Any unutilized sponsorship will go into a pool for the next session.
 - o Teachers have been asked to share information regarding sponsored program spots and application process
- Race For Education

- School Supply Kits
 - o Prices received from First Day School Supplies based on current supply lists for each grade
 - K - \$47, 1st - \$44, 2nd - \$60, 3rd - \$42, 4th - \$60
 - o Supply lists for each grade need to be updated by teachers by April 19th
 - o Sara looking into options to get specific items in bulk, or removing some items to bring cost to \$40 each
 - o Parents would order a supply box online based on student's grade, would ship directly to the school on a pallet at no extra cost to parents, labeled with student name and grade
 - o Orders would have to be placed by 7/1/24 for delivery by 8/1/24
 - o Sara to attend advisory meeting on 3/21 to get idea out to teachers and have them begin to review supply lists
 - o Headphones will be removed from lists and provided by the school moving forward
 - o Need to look into delivery logistics of large pallet
