LaTeX (more precisely, KaTeX) is a bit different and a bit weird in the RocketChat channels. There are **two** ways you can use it:

1. In the **inline mode** which prints the expressions/equations in the same line as the text.

Inline expressions should be written in the same line as the main text and wrapped in \(\(\(\ldots\)\), where \(\ldots\) denotes the LaTeX expression.

For example, to write the message,

This is an example of an inline expression: x=42.

you should write

This is an example of an inline expression: (x = 42).

in the message field, i.e., like so:

 $\bigcirc$  This is an example of an inline expression: (x = 42).



2. In the equation mode which prints the expression/equations in a *separate line* and centered.

Equation expressions should be written *in a separate line* (use Shift + Enter) and wrapped *in* \[ ... \], where ... denotes the LaTeX expression.

This is an example of a full equation:

$$x = 42$$
.

For example, to write the message, you should write

This is an example of an inline expression: [x = 42.]

in the message field, i.e., like so:
