Pupil Premium

With the cost of living crisis affecting us all, many families have discovered that they are now eligible for Free School Meals, which in turn creates funding called Pupil Premium. This is extra money given to schools to ensure all those children who are eligible

are able to receive extra financial support in schools, including free breakfast club and after school club, discounted rates on school visits, extra support academically through enhanced resources as well as free school meals.
