- 1. THS football field is sinking; where are we with this? The field itself was not sinking, the track was and has been repaired.
- 2. The CFO has finalized the language on the RFP for fuel and will submit the document to the CdA Press the week of August 14th to be published per statute.
- 3. The Clerk sent a thank you card to the County Commissioners for their willingness to honor the initial agreement regarding the SRO MOU.
- 4. The abatement at SLE is complete and those classrooms are expected to be fully carpeted by the time teachers return to school.
- 5. The abatement at JBE related to the broken pipe in December is complete and the school will be ready for staff and students to return.
- 6. The Welcome Back Breakfast is scheduled for Monday, August 28th with the program beginning at 8:15 and breakfast beginning at 7:30. We hope the board is able to attend.
- 7. The CFO has finalized the language on the white mini buses and will submit the document to the CdA Press the week of August 14th to be published per statute.
- 8. The auditors will be onsite August 31st and September 1st.
- 9. Colby Mattila resigned his position and a new director has been hired. Bill White has over 20 years of CTE teaching experience and has spent the last few years as an assistant principal and athletic director
- 10. A light post at THS/TMS was hit. We have made contact with the company and they will be paying for the repairs. Email/pics related to this incident are here. The cost of repairs was quoted at \$18, 685.
- 11. A Library Network bus got stuck on the grass at LHS during Rathdrum Days. The bus has been removed and no damage was done to the LHS facility. See email thread here.
- 12. Good news... an engineer inspected the bleachers at the LHS football field. The report is <u>here</u>. Our facilities crew has already taken care of adding some additional supports.
- 13. JBE and SLE were awarded the fresh fruits and vegetables grant, again, for the 2023-24 school year. This grant is based on free and reduced lunch percentages. This is great news for these two schools.
- 14. NIC retained its accreditation. I recommend that we continue to run our dual credit courses through NIC.
