1. Please read the regulations carefully (on back) and **then complete and return the enclosed order form** with a check in the proper amount payable to the Weekapaug Fire District.
2. Pick up is at the Library of the Weekapaug Fire District Office from 10AM until noon on the dates shown below.
3. **All buttons and stickers must be picked up by the owner or tenant. Identification may be required.**

"The Fenway Beach and East Beach (Inn Beach) are owned by the Fire District and are for the benefit and use of the Fire District property owners, their guests and their lessees. These regulations are intended to enable the community to enjoy the beaches to the maximum and in a safe manner."

**EXCERPTS FROM REGULATIONS ADOPTED  
BY THE TAXPAYERS OF THE DISTRICT AT  
THE 1968 ANNUAL MEETING:**

1. Identification by badges and stickers are required of persons authorized to use the beaches or Fire District parking lots, according to rules established from time to time by the Fire District Executive Committee. All such badges and stickers must be shown on request to any Fire District security personnel, employee or officer.
2. All activities in the water are governed by applicable laws of the State of Rhode Island and regulations issued by the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management. A state qualified lifeguard will be at each beach during reasonable hours during the summer season. He/She has the authority to close a beach to swimmers if swimming conditions are dangerous, and such other authority vested in the lifeguards by law.
3. The Executive Committee is authorized to make such further rules and regulations not

inconsistent with any of the ordinances of said Fire District or said Town of Westerly, for the use of Fire District property. (OVER)
