- When: Any day between Monday, October 13th, and Friday, October 17th.

- Deadline: All finished cards must be turned in to Room 317 to Ms. Mason by the end of the school day on Friday, October 17th.
- Aspen Workflow for Parents/Guardians- please complete if you have not already done so for 2025-26 School Year. This needs to be completed each year by families
 - Aspen workflows take the place of paperwork the school used to collect physically. There are three workflows that need to be completed in Aspen; Student Permission, Annual Health Collection, and Update Student Emergency Card (contacts). To complete the workflows, click here to access your Aspen Family Portal. If you need assistance with your Aspen credentials (login), please contact our Guidance department. They have access to view account credentials or reset passwords. Additionally, there is a self-recovery on the login page for forgotten passwords. Please remember that you must use your Aspen username and password in order to complete the workflows (not the student username/password). Also, the Annual Health Collection and Update Student Emergency Card workflows will not reflect any changes until it is accepted by the school. Please do not submit more than once.  - In absence of the workflow completion by parents/guardians, it will be assumed
 that you are agreeing to all the policies and procedures set forth by the school and
 that you have no special requests or restrictions for the school to follow.
 - Additionally, we like to recognize students in weekly emails and newsletters. We
 rely on permissions completed by parents/guardians to publish student photos,
 names, etc so it is important that families update/complete the Aspen workflow.
 - o In addition to the Aspen workflows, parents/guardians can opt out of two additional items for their students if they wish. The items are given below

- **Student Survey Opt out:** Throughout the year, there are several surveys administered by school. These surveys are sometimes required by the RI Department of Education, and to collect student input on other initiatives within the school department. If parents/guardians would like to opt their child out of all surveys administered to the student by the school, please complete THIS form. Please note that parents/guardians must complete one form for each child they wish to opt out of the materials. Parents/Guardians can only opt their child out if they are listed as Primary Contact for the child in Aspen.
- Instructional Materials Opt out: The 2025 US Supreme Court case *Mahmoud v. Taylor* ruling requires school districts to provide parents and guardians with notice about lessons involving LGBTQ+ inclusive materials and to allow them to opt their children out of those lessons based on religious objections. If you wish to receive these notices with the opportunity to opt-out, please complete THIS form. *Please note that parents/guardians must complete one form for each child they wish to opt out of the materials. Parents/Guardians should ONLY complete this form if they wish to receive opt-out notifications. Parents/Guardians can only opt their child out if they are listed as Primary Contact for the child in Aspen.*

Cell Phone Policy implementation - begun Monday 10/6/25

Please be reminded this is in full implementation. Any phones in sight will be confiscated. Please do not use phones in the school building between the school hours (7.15 am - 1.45 pm). No earbuds are allowed to remain in ears when students are in transit. Use of earbuds will automatically imply they are attached to cell phones when students are moving in the building. So please store them away and out of sight. There was a whole month of warning issued. If students refuse to turn in their phones, we will call parents/guardians immediately. Students will not be allowed to continue their school day unless the phone is turned in to school safe. The student phones will remain in the safe for the entire duration. Thank you for your cooperation in advance

- As of October 6, 2025, we will be implementing the consequences as laid out in the handbook
 - First offense phone will be confiscated, name of the student will be documented as first offense and phone will be stored in the school safe. Students can have their phone back at the end of school. No parent/guardian intervention needed

- Second offense- phone will be confiscated and stored in the school safe. Student name will be documented as a second offense and the phone will only be returned to a parent/guardian of the student listed in Aspen
- O Third offense a parent/guardian will need to meet with school administration with the students to develop a plan. Examples of a plan may include the student turning in their phone each day to be put in the safe or leaving their phone home. This plan will be created in partnership with the family.
