

Bamboo Reach Isle



Geography and Landscape

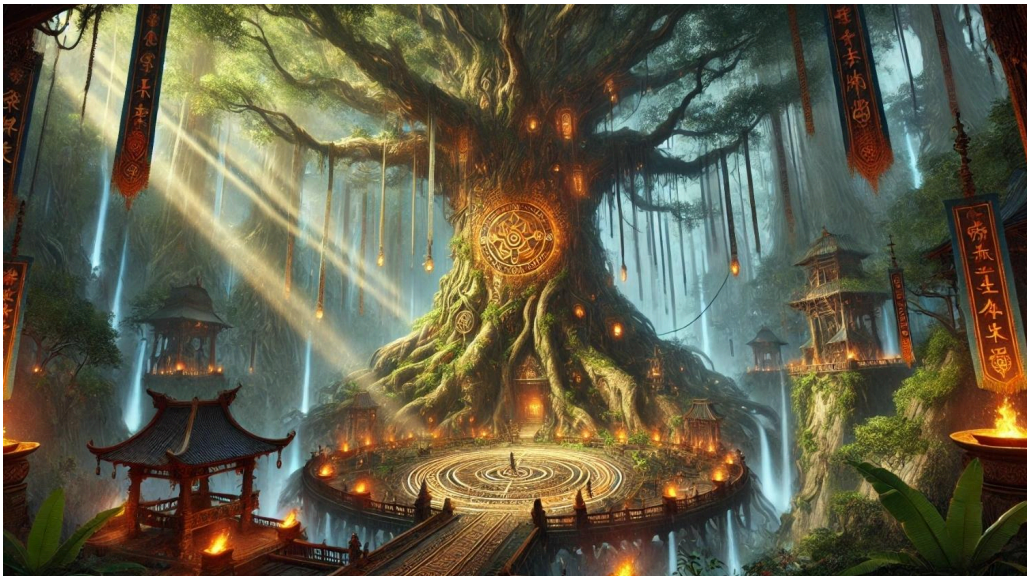
