The Northeastern Athletic Department will be following the listed policies for all Varsity Home Football Games:

- All elementary (k-6) and middle school (7-8) students must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times. Unaccompanied elementary and middle school students will not be permitted to enter the stadium area.
- Any guest under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult unless they are students of Northeastern High School or the visiting team's high school.
- All unaccompanied students in grades 9-12 from Northeastern High School or the visiting team's school must present their student ID to purchase a ticket. Students without their ID will be turned away. Unaccompanied high school students from schools other than the schools participating in the contest will not be permitted.
- The expectation is that all students watch the game from the stands. Students will not be permitted to gather in groups at the ticket gates and concession areas.
- Spectators should not attempt to bring backpacks or other unnecessary items (skateboards, scooters, footballs, chromebooks, etc) to the stadium. Items of this nature will be confiscated and can be picked up after the football game. The district will not be responsible for lost material.
- Any spectator leaving the stadium area during the game will not be permitted back into the stadium area.
- Northeastern School District has the right to request identification for any guests in question attempting to enter ticketed home sporting events.
- Handicap Parking for Varsity Football games can only be accessed using the High School Annex Parking Lot (198 North Hartman Street Manchester PA 17345).
- Tobacco products, vaping, illegal substances, and alcohol are strictly prohibited on District grounds.

Please remind your children that school sporting events are school functions, and students' behavioral expectations are the same as when they are in school. Fighting, profanity, bullying, and harassment will not be permitted. Those joining us at Bobcat Stadium should be there to watch the game and to support the football players, cheerleaders, and the Bobcat Marching Band.

Thank you for taking these matters seriously, and for partnering with us to provide a safe and respectful environment for all members of our school community to learn and spend time together.
