## Cells by Samuel Janas

Cell wall contains cellulose or chitin, its function is mostly protection.

Plasma/cell membrane consists of a lipid bilayer with embedded proteins, it regulates what passes in and out of cell.

Nucleus\* controls centre of cell and directs protein synthesis, it is a membrane-enclosed organelle.

Endoplasmic reticulum\* is a type of organelle in eukaryotic cells that forms an interconnected network of flattened, membrane-enclosed sacs

Golgi apparatus\*      Stacks of flattened vesicles, which packages protein for export.  
Centriole\*      is a cylindrical cell structure which anchor and assemble microtubules  
Cytoskeleton      is a network of protein filaments performing structural support and cell movement  
Chloroplast\*      is a bacteria-like element found in plants, which conducts photosynthesis  
Mitochondria\*      bacteria-like element, which carries out cellular respiration.  
Central Vacuole\*      Large membrane=bound sac in plants, which storages (mostly) water and sugars
