

STATEMENT OF KRIS COOPER

On March 10th at 11:00 a.m. - I met with Doug Goodwin and Joe White. We read a letter from the attorneys of the family accusing Pete of sexual misconduct with their son. At 11:30 a.m. - We bring Pete in to tell us what he knows of the situation with this family. He tell us that this bc [redacted] and his friend had come to Branson to visit Pete 6 or 7 years ago. Pete admitted to mutual masturbation with [redacted] and in the presences of the friend. No touching took place with the friend. We asked Pete if there were any other boys that he has touched in this way ever. He said No. We asked if he had masturbated with other boys. He gave us 4 other names than the two previously mentioned. [redacted] (years ago) [redacted] (years ago) [redacted] (10 years ago) and [redacted] (10 years ago). We asked Pete if he had been involved in any sexual misbehavior with any other kids. He said Yes. Skinny dipping in his hot tub with [redacted] and [redacted]. We asked if any touching went on. Pete said No. We asked if any misbehavior had gone on. He said No and A had placed their penis up against the jets that was it. We asked again if Pete has had any sexual contact either him touching someone or someone touching him. He said No.

We told Pete he could no longer work at Kamp and that he needed to leave Branson that day. We told him he could not contact [redacted] family, he could not contact any Kanakuk Kampers or their families, and he should have no contact with any one here in Branson. We took his cell phone, his computer, his files and locked his office.

Pete left town that evening.

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
