SDOTs (Standardized Direct Observation Tools)

These are checklists used to ensure a learner can perform a procedure or task. [Here](#), you will find a collection of these checklists used to assess a student's ability to use point of care ultrasound accurately and appropriately. It is recommended the student refer to these on scan shift to ensure they pass the SDOT during their final week. You can have the checklist in front of you during the SDOT evaluation. You need to complete at least 5 to pass the course.

Final Exam

The final exam will be near the end of your 4th week of the rotation. It is 70 questions and you will have 90 mins to finish it. It is heavily based on the SAEM and Core Ultrasound video content and the Nobel book (Blue) available for checkout from the ultrasound library at any time. A score of greater than 70% passes. Same day remediation is available. This [Study Sheet](#) has many numbers and values you will need to remember for the exam. Bookmarking function does not work, use paper/pen to remember questions to go back to. You may take the test virtually if desired, however we will need to scan your testing environment visually via your provided camera. If you are not willing to agree to a scan of your testing environment, contact me immediately for an alternative solution.
