<b>BUILDINGS</b>	A compilation of rural and smaller community-specific resources pulled out from the <a href="#">Buildings</a> Climate Caucus Handbook. Greenhouse gas emissions (GHGs) from buildings account for a significant amount of Canada's overall emissions, adding up to <a href="#">111 million tonnes or about 17% of Canada's total emissions</a> .
