- Planning meeting August 21 - Recap
- Recap 8/21 Baseball Planning Meeting
  - 15 participants – 1 NOCO, 2 St Charles, 1 West County, 5 SoCen, 3 SOCO, 3 CYC Office
  - Discussed results of survey (944 participants). Largest topics for discussion: 1. Improve Schedule, 2. Field Availability, 3. Travel Distance, 4. Umpire recruiting/retaining, 5. Avoiding game reschedules due to lack of players/conflicts.
  - Possible rules to address: Full cage on baseball helmets, Should top seed in playoffs get to be the home team (currently determined by coin toss), strict enforcement of 48-hour notice/forfeit.

  - Compliance issues for coaches
    - CYC Office is checking and organizations need to ensure coaches have completed Prevent and Protect BEFORE being placed on a roster and allowed to be at practices. We have found over 100 noncompliant coaches on rosters
  - Create yellow/red card tracker on TS sites
    - Reminder - any coach or player receiving a yellow 2 yellow cards within 30 days is suspended for 3 games
  - Collecting feedback from coaches when reporting scores -
    - has been added to STC, SCen, and WC sites
  - Game Record Collector Link on website - ability to collect photos of game records from officials/coordinators

### **New Topics of Discussion**

- Team fee discussion
  - Individual rates for each district based on the officials reimbursement rates were proposed and will be finalized by 9/15.
- Dual Rostering

- For Basketball, we are proposing to move the dual roster number to 12,13,14 or 15 with a max roster of 9.
- The original vote was to start at 10 (and 11), with a max roster of 8.

The premise is that 10 is a good number for a team, 11 is not that different considering a player or 2 may miss games for conflicts or sickness, but 12 is when it becomes more difficult to manage the roster and playing time.

## Basketball Rule Changes

1. Rule 5, Section 5, Art 2.

OLD - b. Five-minute intermission between halves

NEW - b. Four-minute intermission between halves

2. Rule 5, Section 7

EXCEPTION: League games will have only one extra period. Each team will be allowed one time-out during the extra period of league games.

3. Rule 5 Section 11

**ART. 4...**A time-out shall not be granted until after the ball has become live to start the game. The additional time-out provided for each extra period(s) shall not be granted until after the ball has become live to start the extra period(s). Only one time out is allowed in a league game in the extra period.

4. Playoff timing rule was not adjusted in 2023, so no wording changes are needed.

The sport chairs voted to keep the running clock in all games, league and playoffs.

5. In 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, not putting the score on the scoreboard is not in the rulebook, as it is considered a supplemental rule for districts that may choose to do this.

The Sport chairs voted to allow each district to make the decision for this if they choose to promote sportsmanship and the instructional nature of our 3rd grade games.
