MILWAUKEE – Escape to Hawaii for a fraction of the cost this spring break on March 7, 8 or 9 at 7 p.m. The UWM Manfred Olson Planetarium will be welcoming students and the community for an opportunity to explore the Hawaiian sky with its event, *Lei with the Stars*.

The show will highlight constellations from Hawaii's latitude and demonstrate how the Hawaiian people navigated using the stars. The show will cost \$5 per ticket and may be purchased online in advance or at the door. Each guest will receive a lei and complimentary punch.
