How do we help families enroll?
 different from school-year learning hubs, summer program enrollment won't be using codes or filtering through SFUSD CBOs will do outreach and directly enroll kids students who currently attend learning hubs will still need to apply & enroll for summer programs if they'd like to participate
How can we support?
 partner with your site lead agency CBO to strategize on students to invite since it's likely there will be fewer spots than interested & eligible students if your site does not currently partner with a CBO, your eligible families may complete this SF Parks & Rec interest form to get connected.
What about learning hubs for the remainder of this school year '20/21?
there won't be outreach to fill learning hub spots after April 30, 2021
