Yes, so there's a child in my class (and we've got them in all classes) where perhaps the traditional style of learning, of sitting, listening to the teacher doesn't suit him but actually using the technology, you can use that as an engagement tool to actually actually get him to want to engage with the learning. And actually, he is working in a lot of subjects lower than his peers but using the technology today, he was able to work alongside his peers. He was able to get the questions, the same questions that they were doing, he was doing it. But because of the tech supporting him, he was able to access it and his one:one was almost [just] there facilitating it and just keeping him going. But the tech is the thing that's driving him forwards because he really enjoys using the technology, and a lot of our children do, and so that is actually a bit of a way into the learning for them.
