

# Open Mapping Hub Asia Pacific SOTM Asia 2022 Scholarships

The annual State of the Map Asia Conference comes back after a 2 year hiatus due to the COVID pandemic. Initial target location was in Sri Lanka but was then moved later on to the Philippines. This year's SOTM Asia will be hosted by the local Pista ng Mapa Organizers with Bicol University as its university host partner.

Targeting 300 participants (200 local, 100 international), this year's SOTM Asia will be hosted in the cradle of the world's perfect cone volcano - Mayon Volcano in Legazpi City, Albay. Furthermore, the program will be a 5-day conference allocating 2-days for the Pista ng Mapa local Conference, 1-day for a workshop day, and 2 days for State of the Map Asia. Participants are encouraged to join and observe the whole program to immerse themselves in the local community, lovely culture, and breath-taking cuisine and tourism.

In line with this, OMH AP will be providing scholarships for interested participants throughout the region from within its 18 priority countries from Asia.

# Selected participants will be covered only with the following expenses:

- 1. Airfare Cost and Taxi
- 2. Accommodations for 6 days
- 3. Visa Fees
- 4. Conference Registration Meals during the conference and Socials Night

# General Eligibility for interested participants:

- 1. Should be 18 years old and above
- 2. Should have a valid passport already
- 3. Should come from among the OMH AP priority countries in Asia

# Application

There will be three (3) ways participants may apply for the OMH AP SOTMA and you may apply in one or all methods

# Scholarship:

- <u>Community Nomination</u> You may self-nominate or nominate someone that has been a crucial part of your OSM community. Seven (7) to nine (9) scholars will be selected.
- <u>Mapping Challenge</u> Map buildings in selected HOT Tasking Manager Projects. The top two (2) mappers will be selected.
- <u>Map Poster Making Competition</u> Design a map poster that we can share at the State of the Map Asia 2022! The best map poster will be selected for the scholarship.

# Post Event Requirements for Scholars

- 1. Require to post one (1) OSM Blog 3 weeks after the conference about:
  - a. Learnings
  - b. Challenges
  - c. Recommendations
- 2. Social Media Posts during the Conference with recommended Hashtags
- 3. Host one (1) Sharing Online Webinar for their community members (1-2 months after the conference)
- 4. **OSM Guru Eligibility** Open Mapping Hub is preparing to have a training certification program for individuals that have experience in conducting basic OSM training. Through this program we will be providing a quiz/assignment for eligible gurus which we can tap for future localized training from the hub and



partners. This will allow streamline training and let local community trainers take the lead. (*More information in the following weeks*)

• The Poster should be for A0 size (841×1189 mm) in landscape or portrait

The SotM Asia team hopes to showcase all submitted posters at the SoTM Asia onsite exhibit and publish them on our website and some other SotM channels under CC BY SA 3.0 (or later).

One (1) winner will be chosen to present their poster onsite through a lightning talk at the State of the Map Asia 2022 in Albay, Bicol, Philippines. The winner will be provided a travel grant shouldering the international travel costs, accommodation, and tickets for the whole conference
