

13 Colonies Map

Create a Google MyMap of the 13 Colonies with the following details:

(4 layers: B thru E. Title the layer the red-underlined words in each section)

A. Open and Name a Google MyMap (1 pt) ([Video Example](#))

- a. Open your Google Drive, select “New” and scroll down and right to Google My maps
 - b. Rename map from “Untitled” to “*Period - YourName - Colonial Map*” (9th - TJohnson - Colonial Map).
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B. The Five Early English Colonies (1st Layer) ([Video Example](#))

- a. Pin for each of the five early English Colonies (1 point each - 5 points)
 - i. Roanoke (North Carolina)
 - ii. Sagadahoc (today is Phippsburg, Maine)
 - iii. Jamestown (Virginia)
 - iv. Plymouth (Massachusetts)
 - v. Salem (Massachusetts)
 - b. 3 Facts for Each of the Five Colonies in description box (1 pt for each fact - 15 points total)
 - i. Date founded
 - ii. People that founded
 - iii. Other
 - c. Image for Each of the Five Colonies inserted in the description box (5 points)
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C. Outline Each of the 13 Colonies in a Separate Polygon (2nd Layer)

([Video Example](#))

- Short description in the description box on how each of the colonies were founded.
 - Each polygon should be a different color.
- (1 point each or 13 points)
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D. Outline Each of the 3 Colonial Regions in a Separate Polygon (3rd Layer)

- List facts about the Climate, Resources, and Economic Activities in description box (3 pts each region, 9 pts total).
 - List facts about the People and Culture in the description box (2 pts for each region, 6 pts total).
 - Each polygon should be a different color.
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E. The “Four Firsts” - pin the following (4th Layer) Label it the name of the place and enter the following in the description box. (See Video Example for part B)

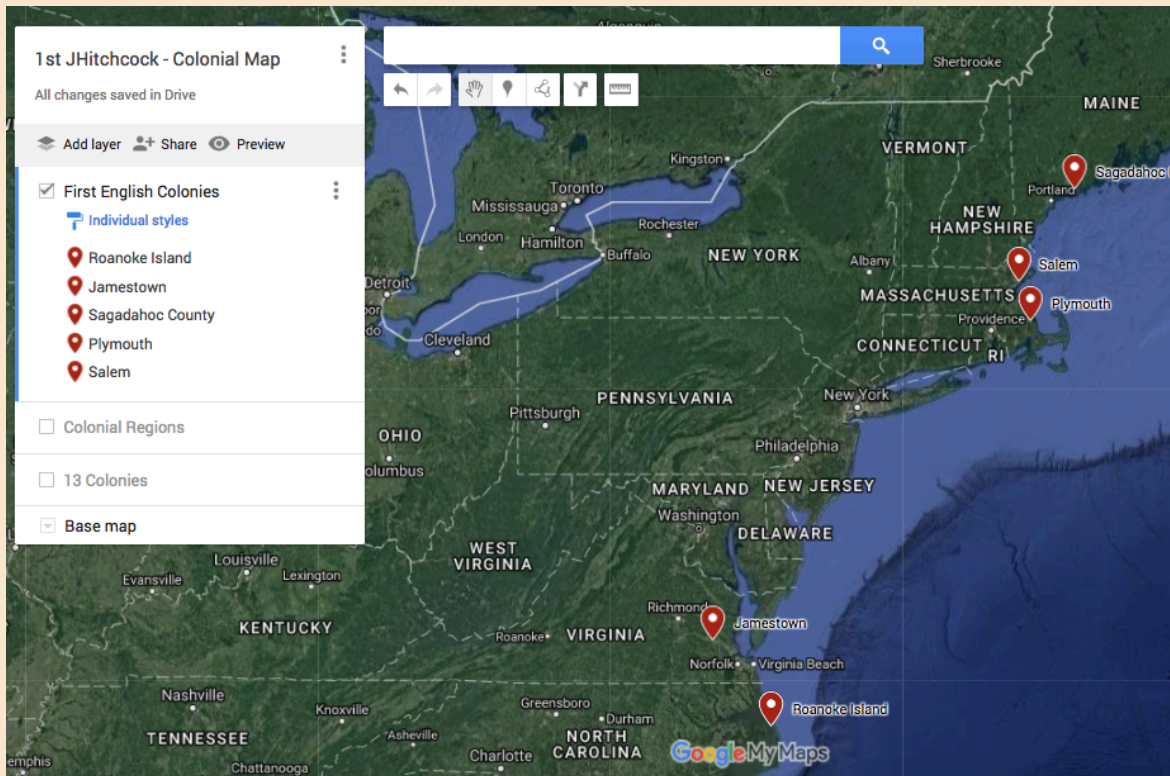
- The first permanent English Colony in the New World.

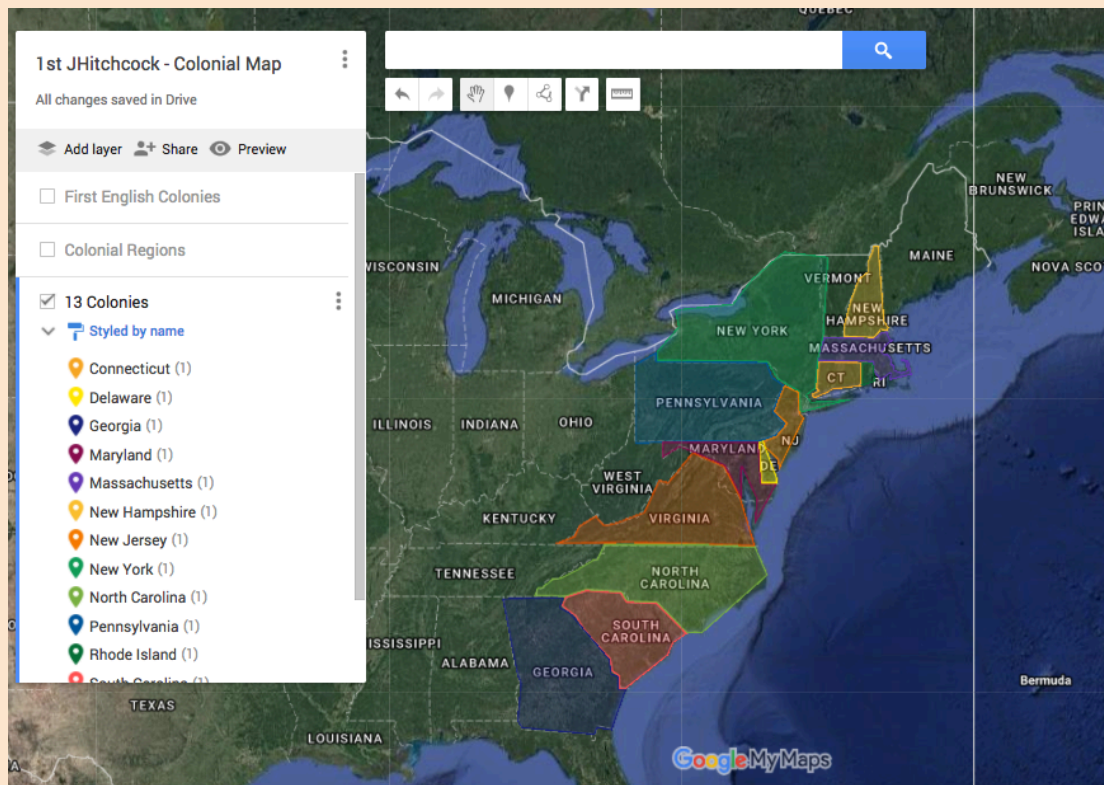
