Change of clothing (pants/shorts,socks, underwear(if not in Pull-up/Diapers)

Seasonally appropriate. Please send these in a backpack in ziploc bag.(with child name on it).

Pull-Ups/Diapers that attach on the sides **(please no slide up pull-ups)**

A reusable water bottle that your child can drink from- bottles will be sent home on Fridays to be washed over the weekend

2 blankets items (crib sheet the children do not sleep in cribs, crib sheets fit our classroom cots) and blanket or (2 blankets) .These stay at school and will send them home each Friday. Rest time is required by law. If your child does not nap, we do encourage them to remain in their designated resting area on their cot with a quiet activity that we provide.

Bookbag: Please be sure that your child's backpack is a typical backpack size that they can carry themselves. We send items home daily and if they do not fit in the backpack it is difficult to ensure these items get home.

Items do not have to be individually wrapped, boxes/containers are fine.
