SUMMER SESSION 2023: Loyola's 2023 Summer Session is an excellent time to catch up, get ahead, or learn something new! The session will run from *June 19th through July 14th* with school holidays on July 3rd and July 4th and offers over 70 courses in more than 13 academic areas for young men and women entering the 6th – 12th grades in the fall.

- New this summer:
 1. Loyola Idea Lab is a course where you imagine it, design it, and build it! The course is a combination between a science lab, a woodshop, a computer lab, and an art room.
 2. AI Scholars High School Course is a two-week project-based program taught by Stanford, MIT AI, and top university researchers, which will explore the foundations of machine learning and explore different applications of machine learning models.

- We are excited to be offering again this summer:
 1. The Sports and Leadership class is an online, two-week course which will meet Monday - Thursday evenings, June 19 – 29, and will focus on best leadership practices for high school athletes.

- For our current freshmen summer session offers:
 1. Introduction to Advanced Placement World History, a great class to help prepare current freshmen for the AP World History course.
 2. Introduction to Honors Algebra 2 is a fast-paced class to help prepare those students transitioning from Algebra 1 into Honors Algebra II in the fall.

3. Need to brush up on Spanish? We offer Spanish in Review and a Bridge Class to Spanish II Honors.

4. Summer Reading 10 (in person or online) is designed to meet the Loyola summer reading requirement.

- For our current sophomores and juniors summer session offers:

2. In the sciences, we offer Pre-AP Biology and Pre-AP Chemistry.

3. Want to take care of your summer reading requirement? Our Summer Reading 11 and 12 courses combine seven online meetings with additional assignments or check-ins throughout the week.

- For our current juniors summer session offers:

1. Back by popular demand is a one-week College Application Essay Writing Workshop, which will be taught by members of our Counseling Department. The first session begins June 12th, the week before Summer Session.
