1st-3rd Grades	Notes / Roles & Responsibilities
Opening music - Let's welcome everyone. SING <i>We Are Together - Hinei Ma Tov</i> (Jay Rapoport)	[Scott] Welcome wishes. Boker tov. [Mentors] Sing, clap where appropriate for the song.
Thanking God for being here. Good morning. [p.24] Ensure students know when this prayer is said and why. SING <i>Modeh / Modah Ani</i> (Klepper/Freelander) with stretches.	[Scott] "Let's thank God for waking us up so we can spend another day in the world." [Mentors] Sing and guide the stretches.
Holiday, theme, and/or other fun songs. SING <i>This Is What We Need To Build A Sukkah</i> (Friedman) SING <i>Ufaratzta</i> (Chassidic)	[Scott] Teach, explain. [Mentors] Lead motions for <i>Ufaratzta</i> .
Nisim B'Chol Yom - For Daily Miracles [pp.36-40] / ברכות השחר (morning blessings) What are you grateful for today? Call on volunteers from a variety of grades to come up and complete each blessing in English. CHANTED with Hebrew and English.	[Scott] "It's time to say what we're grateful for this morning." [Mentors] Each should say a blessing for which they are thankful (as an example so that everyone knows what we're doing). <i>Baruch Atah, Adonai, eloheinu melech haolam for _____.</i> [Mentors] Call on one of your 8th/9th grade peers to stand with their paired 1st-3rd graders to say what miracles they're thankful for as we say the blessing. Make sure that at least two kids from each grade are able to share. Vary students each week. Lead the intro to each blessing (the Hebrew above).
Call To Worship [p.58] SING <i>Am I Awake / Bar'chu</i> (Noah Aronson)	[Scott] [Mentors] Ask all to rise. Guide bowing. You are the leaders, so you do the first blessing. Then, the congregation responds.
Shema Uvirchotaha (Sh'ma and Its Blessings) [pp.64-68] SING <i>Sh'ma</i> (Pik) SING <i>V'ahavta</i> (Isaacson)	[Scott] [Mentors] Rise for the <i>Sh'ma</i> . Sing, hand customs, clap, etc. accordingly.
Mi Chamocha - Redemption [p.72] SING <i>Mi Chamocha</i> (Debbie Friedman)	If time permits... [Scott] Intro blessing. [Mentors] Sing, raise the energy (we are free!), clap, etc. accordingly.
A Wish for Peace [p.100] SING <i>Oseh Shalom</i> (Elana Jagoda)	[Scott] Intro the wish. [Mentors] Sing, raise the energy, clap, etc. accordingly.
