- You are a Saint Paul Church member in good standing
 - o A member for at least 6 months
- You are 25 years old or younger
- Planning to attend or you are currently enrolled in a:
 - 4-year institution
 - 2-year institution
 - Bible Colleges for first-time students
 - Vocational or Community College
 - You are taking a minimum of 12 course credits
 - You maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA

FAQ's

Q: How often will I receive a scholarship distribution?

A: The scholarship award will be distributed in two or three equal payments. These payments will precede quarter or semester sessions. For institutions whose registration sessions do not fall under quarters or semesters, please inform the Scholarship Chairperson.

Q: How will the Scholarship Committee know I am a student in good standing or have a minimum of 9 course credits?

A: The scholarship recipient should contact the Scholarship Committee Chairperson once he or she has registered. The Student must submit their request no later than 30 days from receiving verification of class schedule. All students must show proof of full time enrollment (registration or class schedule).

Q: How do I get my information to the Scholarship Committee?

A: Complete the <u>DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD REQUEST FORM.</u> Incomplete information may delay disbursement. You may email your information to the Scholarship Committee at scholarship@saintpaulsac.org. If you need assistance, email the Scholarship Committee Chairperson at scholarship@saintpaulsac.org. (Do not contact the Church Office)

Q: Will the Scholarship Committee write the check to me to take to my school or college? What if I need the scholarship award to register for school? How will I pay for tuition?

A: The preference is for all awards to be sent directly to your College or University. Under certain circumstances the check can be picked up from the church office. The check will be drawn in the name of the institution and the recipient. The check must be endorsed over to the institution by the recipient. Under no circumstances is the student to receive cash. Complete the DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD REQUEST FORM first and coordinate pickup by emailing the Scholarship Committee Chairperson at scholarship@saintpaulsac.org.

Q: How will the Debbie Cager Music Scholarship be paid for my private lessons?

A: Students receiving the Debbie Cager Music Scholarship must submit a paid receipt from their music instructor for reimbursement or the payment will be paid directly to the music instructor.
