## ***What are Right At School programs like?***

Right At School programs keep students active, engaged, and healthy every day. We play group sports and fitness games - and take it outside as much as possible! Students who have homework have dedicated quiet time to focus on that, with support from our talented educators. We incorporate service learning through Right Club Gives Back - student-chosen and student-led community service projects. Whether it's our afterschool program, a kindergarten program, or our holiday break camp, you can rely on a safe and fun program led by nurturing and dedicated educators.

## ***Can Right At School accommodate my special needs child?***

When children with special needs seek to enroll, our staff will work with your family to determine the best placement for the child. We review every situation on a case-by-case basis to determine if the Right At School large-group setting meets your child's needs. Our staff will collaborate with our Right At School Inclusion Specialist, your family, and school staff/outside providers (with permission from parents) to best support each child.

## ***Are you licensed in the State of Wisconsin?***

Yes! When we partner with a district, we license through the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families.

## ***Do you partner with other area districts?***

Yes! We provide out of school time and summer programming in the Wauwatosa School District as well as area charter schools like Seeds of Health and at the Woodlands Bluemound Campus.

## ***Who are Right At School staff?***

Right At School staff are local, dedicated and experienced professionals with a passion for working with children. All educators must pass a fingerprint background check and state-required checks. They also participate in comprehensive, blended learning training programs, which provide extensive safety, education and positive- guidance-focused training throughout the year.

## ***Will there be a wait list?***

While we strive to avoid wait lists, there may be space constraints that limit the number of students we can enroll. We encourage families to register promptly to secure your child's spot when registration opens.

**When will registration take place?**

Registration will open on March 23 2026. In the meantime, Right At School will host virtual and in-person family information forums to ensure a smooth registration process. The annual registration fee is \$75.00/family.

**Do you offer any discounts?**

Yes! We offer a 10% sibling discount, a 20% Affordable Access Discount, and a 10% Military discount. Hamilton School District staff are also afforded a discount as well. To learn more about the staff discount, please inquire with the district.

**When is Tuition due?**

Right at School charges tuition monthly. Tuition for our before and after-school programs can be paid in full, or you can choose to pay in installments by selecting our payment plan option. Payments will be distributed throughout the year in monthly installments. During the registration process, if you select our payment plan option, your payment schedule will be available for your review.

**Do you accept Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy?**

Yes! If you qualify we happily accept Wisconsin Shares Child Care Subsidy. If you require assistance in learning if you qualify, and how to apply, we are also happy to assist in navigating that process.

**Are you open on non-school days?**

Yes! We operate programming on days no school is in session, but the district is still open. We offer a non-school day program option of \$60/day.

### ***What are Drop Ins and Punch Cards?***

Drop-in care is a flexible option for families who need occasional Right Club Before or After School care. Families may also purchase drop-in care or punch cards. All drop-in and punch card days must be pre-scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. You should also notify your child's school-day teacher to help ensure a safe and smooth transition to the program. Drop-In care is \$50.00 and Punch Cards are available for \$450.00 to Hamilton School District families enrolled in the programming. We utilize our local, floating staff pool to ensure we maintain compliance with Wisconsin licensing ratios in order to offer these flexible options to families. *Please note, due to space constraints, drop-ins and punch cards are currently unavailable at Willow Springs.*

### ***Can I change my child's schedule?***

Absolutely! We just recommend families do so a week prior to when the schedule change is needed. Requests may take 2-3 business days to process, so please make sure we receive your request before your next billing cycle.

### ***Will summer programming be available?***

Summer School morning and afternoon programming will be offered in 2027. Further information regarding summer programming will be provided in Fall 2026.
